POUDRE TRAIL

The Cache la Poudre River is the lifeblood for water resources in Northern Colorado. The Poudre River Trail is 21 miles of well-maintained and wide paved pathway, with gentle grades and natural beauty for walking, cycling, running, rollerblading and more. Accessible from multiple locations between Windsor and Greeley. The trail is open to the public with river access and includes informational signs that highlight many of the historical sites along the way.
